



SPARKLING WINE

Lively bubbles to give you a flip. The pick-me-up effervescence in sweeter versions is from infused carbon dioxide whilst quality Méthode Cap Classique wines enjoy a second fermentation in the bottle, as in Champagne. They offer a freshly baked bread nose and broad, yeasty palate, ideal as an aperitif or with oysters. Milder, soft French cheese is also a good match.

VILLIERA TRADITION (Stellenbosch) R175

Bottle fermented. Delectably dry with a pronounced yeasty character.

PONGRACZ (Coastal) 190

Méthode Cap Classique. Elegant wine with fine yeastiness and pinprick bubbles.

GRAHAM BECK BRUT (Robertson) R220

Méthode Cap Classique blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Barrel and bottle fermented, hint of yeast with a dry finish.

PIERRE JOURDAN CUVÉE BELLE ROSE (Franschhoek) R240

Méthode Cap Classique from 100% Pinot Noir. Soft, fruity, elegant, refreshingly dry finish with a tinge of pink.

MAXIMILLIAN 1 PROSECCO (Veneto, Italy) R235

Dry, yet soft with a slightly aromatic bouquet, smooth flavours and great character. Ideal as an apéritif and between meals or with delicate dishes.

COLIN 'BLANCHE DE CASTILLE' (France) R670

Première cru, 100% Chardonnay. Exceptional Champagne – floral nose with white flowers and touches of summer fruits with a persistent mousse.

MOËT ET CHANDON NON VINTAGE BRUT IMPÉRIAL (France) R1100

Largest producer of Champagne with consistent good quality.

VEUVE CLIQUOT NV (France) R1120

Rich, full and fruity, reflecting the influence of Pinot Noir in the base wine

BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVÉE (France) R1400

Made in clearly distinguished style. A Champagne of great depth and character.

LOUIS ROEDERER BRUT PREMIER (France) R1500

This houses smallish production and adherence to high standards ensured good quality throughout the range. A delicious wine, with some fine biscuity overtones.

LAURENT PERRIER CUVÉE ROSÉ BRUT (France) R1700

Rounded and supple with fresh fruit reminiscent of raspberries, black cherries and blackcurrants as well as a full range of Pinot Noir aromas.

DOM PERIGNON (France) R3700

Luxurious Champagne from the house of Moët et Chandon. Consistently one of the finest Champagnes produced.

DRY WHITE BLENDS AND OTHER VARIETIES

Ranging from light and fluffy to deep and serious, the hallmark is consistency. The wine makers craft is to blend wines from different grape types to create style consumers trust.

2011 ALLEE BLEUE SAUV BLANC/CHENIN BLANC (Franschhoek) R65

Vibrant gooseberry, passion fruit, perfume, flavours and racy freshness.

2011 BUITENVERWACHTING BUITEN BLANC (Constantia) R100

Sauvignon Blanc dominated blend. Delicious floral Muscat fruitiness.

2011 HAUTE-CABRIERE PINOT NOIR CHARDONNAY (Franschhoek) R140

Charming ensemble with wispy floral raspberry flavour.



RHINE RIESLING

Traditionally grown in Germany, but this variety has adapted quite well to local conditions, producing wines in a variety of styles from dry to sweet. Rieslings are seldom, if ever oaked and they can age extremely well. Crouchen Blanc, erroneously named Cape Riesling, is no relative.

2007 VILLIERA (Stellenbosch) R110

Lingering canned pineapple and marmalade notes, integrated and finely rich.

2009 THEUNISKRAAL RIESLING (Tulbagh) R110

Light fruity white wine.

CHENIN BLANC

This versatile workhorse grape's time has come. Long the unsung ugly sister, its true potential is recognised, as it becomes fashionable. Originally from the Loire Valley in France, Chenin or Steen in the Cape produces diverse style dry to sweet and is increasingly wood matured. It's equally dextrous at the table.

2010 TEDDY HALL (Stellenbosch) R80

Zesty and refreshing with great balance. Guava and Peach aromas with a fresh palate that finishes with a lingering sensation of tropical fruit and wild honey

2010 VILLIERA (Stellenbosch) R90

Apricot/pineapple aromas with waves of tropical fruit and intriguing clove seasoning.

2009 & 2010 KEN FORRESTER (Stellenbosch) R145

A superb "Loire" wooded style Chenin, bold style with full middle palate.

2006 JEAN DANEEL SIGNATURE CHENIN (Coastal, Napier) R220

Made in the French traditional method and matured for 13 months in small French oak barrels. Winner of the 2008 Chenin Challenge.

OFF DRY & SEMI-SWEET

The sweeter tooth can delight in aromatic blends of scented varieties like Rhine Riesling, Gewürztraminer and Muscat. A potpourri of floral characters set off the grapey taste supported by natural residual grape sugar. Spicy, lightly curried dishes are good accompaniments.

2009 VERGELEGEN VIN DE FLORENCE (Stellenbosch) R90

Off dry. Fragrant, easy drinking blend of Gewürztraminer, Chenin Blanc, Sauvignon Blanc and Rhine Riesling.

2010 VILLIERA GEWURZTRAMINER (Stellenbosch) R100

Luxurious rosepatel notes matched by yummy litchi fresh, pure acidity cleans the tail; off-dry, for fusion food.

2010 BUITENVERWACHTING "G" (Constantia) R220

Lichees, Turkish delight, roses – all in one bottle! Typical Gewürztraminer – the closest to Alsace you can get; yet bone dry. Have with the curry of your choice. Amazing wine - not for the faint hearted.

BLANC DE NOIR

Francophiles will recognise this literal translation of "white from black". Clear juice of black grapes gains colour from brief skin contact during fermentation to produce a salmon pink blush. Of fleshy berry character and often from Pinotage, a touch of sweetness complements the fruity cornucopia. Fish, fowl and light red meat plates go well.

2011 ALLEE BLEUE ROSE (Franschhoek) R75

Lovely cherry blossom colour. Fruit driven style with abundant sweet strawberry and rose petal aromas. Also a hint of spiciness that derives from the Shiraz grapes. The palette reminds of candy floss with hints of raspberry. A well balanced and cheerful dry Rose.

2011 BUITENVERWACHTING (Constantia) R100

This salmon pink blend of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon offers fresh strawberry Characters with subtle undertones of peach flavours.

2011 DURBANVILLE HILLS MERLOT - ROSE (Durbanville) R100

This Merlot Rosé is a light bodied and fruity wine with hints of fresh summer berries on the palate. It's affectionately known as the ideal summer wine! Light strawberry in colour, this wine has hints of raspberries dusted by rose petals on the nose.

2010 WATERFORD ROSE - MARY (Waterford, Stellenbosch) R125

A low alcohol salmon coloured wine made from crushing fresh red grape varieties immediately after picking. Crisp with fresh spicy flavours! Dominant cultivars include Shiraz, Mourvedre and Sangiovese.



SAUVIGNON BLANC

User-friendly "Savage Plonk" may well be wild but seldom plonk: Styles range from frisky young grassy examples to developed blue gum, gooseberry and asparagus character. This variety marries well with wood, Fume Blanc and matches well with shellfish and white meats.

2011 NIEL JOUBERT (Paarl) R80

Pale yellow with bright reflections - gentle nose at the start with hints of ripe gooseberry, green apple and some citrus. Good balance and long well flavoured finish.

2011 EXCELSIOR (Robertson) R90

Zesty Sauvignon brims with fresh fig, green pepper and gooseberry flavours.

2010 RAKA (Klein River, Stanford) R85

Complex character. Light clear colour, aromas of tropical fruit (kumquats and gooseberries) with a hint of linden.

2011 DURBANVILLE HILLS (Durbanville) R110

Tropical fruit to fig, lime, guava and gooseberry, leading up to a crisp finish. Pale green in colour, this wine is a combination of fruit flavours and green pepper with a crisp acidity and full mouth-feel.

2011 FAIRVIEW DARLING (Paarl) R115

Crisply dry, grapefruit and mineral flavoured delight that will compliment seafood, grilled chicken or a warm goats cheese salad.

2009 BELLINGHAM (Franschhoek) R120

A fantastically fresh and fascinating Sauvignon with a splash of Viognier. Appealing floral, green fig and pear drop fragrances and flavours

2011 VILLIERA (Stellenbosch) R120

Dense, gooseberry grassy bouquet, dry but not lean, gutsy

2011 DIEMERSDAL (Durbanville) R120

Tropical fruits, figs and gooseberries combine beautifully in the mouth, along with a mineral character. This wine has a long fruity finish.

2011 THELEMA (Stellenbosch) R135

Nice varietal characteristics, rich, full, pungent. One of SA's finest.

2011 BUITENVERWACHTING (Constantia) R155

A wine with superbly concentrated flavours. Its excellent balance and good ageing ability, make it one of the leading local Sauvignon.

2011 NEIL ELLIS GROENEKLOOF (Stellenbosch) R155

Distinct fruity sweetness with dry finish. Among the Cape's finest.

2010 JORDAN (Stellenbosch) R155

Aromatic gooseberries, figs rich in tropical undertones.

2010 SOUTHERN RIGHT (Walker bay, Hermanus) R165

Intense gooseberry and tropical fruit flavours yet pleasingly elegant and moderate. Named after the rare Southern Right whales which visit Walker Bay between May and December each year.

2010 & 2011 ATARAXIA (Walker Bay, Hermanus) R170

This wine favours individuality ahead of pure, pungent fruit, but still shows assertive green asparagus, gooseberry and grassy aromas.

2011 SPRINGFIELD LIFE FROM STONE (Robertson) R170

The new vintage from Springfield. A stormer, probably the best tasted from Robertson.

2009 OAK VALLEY (Elgin) R180

The cool growing climate of Elgin provides slow ripening fruit which results in wines of distinctive character and style.



CHARDONNAY

This regal white grape can produce sublime, complex art forms at home in Burgundy, France. New World examples without wood treatment flaunt limey; citrus flavours while barrel fermentation and maturation adds broad, buttery vanilla features. Best with food.

2011 NIEL JOUBERT (Paarl) R80

Pale with bright yellow reflections. Nose leads with ripe tropical fruit where citrus, melon and pineapple mingle. Hints of vanilla and some floral notes.

2011 EIKENDAL UNWOODED (Stellenbosch) R95

Fresh citrus nose, outlined with delicate sweet melon aromas with hints of butterscotch. Intricate Explosion of flavours, expressing a peach-lime combo with golden delicious infusions.

2009 BELLINGHAM (Franschhoek) R120

A richly expressive Chardonnay with a mere dash of Viognier. Fragrant peach and lemon cream appeal.

2011 JORDAN UNWOODED (Stellenbosch) R150

Flavours of lemon-zest with hints of peach and apricot add complexity to the full rich palate. Extended lees contact integrates the creamy citrus flavours with layers of tropical fruit.

2010 FAIRVIEW (Paarl) R150

A crisp dry Chardonnay with citrus peel, dried peach, grapefruit, subtle oak and mineral flavours.

2009 EDGEBASTON (Stellenbosch) R155

Shows typical lime citrus and cinnamon aromas with tight minerality. With a floral note of frangipani and almond blossom brought about by the small amount of botrytis.

2009 THELEMA (Stellenbosch) R185

Lovely citrus flavours with a hint of pineapple, subtle wood. It's hard to believe the wine was in barrel for 11 months.

2009 BUITENVERWACHTING (Constantia) R210

Golden yellow; toasty butterscotch with hints of Honeysuckle, well integrated wood.

2010 BOUCHARD FINLAYSON (Walker Bay, Hermanus) R220

Densely flavoured fresh palate from cool region.

2008 & 2009 ATARAXIA (Walker Bay, Hermanus) R350

Expressive aromas of pear, grilled almond, grapefruit and white flowers. The palate is penetrating and persistent yet graceful and poised.

2006 SPRINGFIELD METHODE ANCIENE (Robertson) R400

Ripened by sunny days and picked at night in very low temperatures to ensure quality. A wine of distinctive and classical character. Tropical fruit nuances layered by lime and cream.

2005 JOSEPH DROUHIN CHABLIS (Burgundy, France) R480

Fruity and fragrant nose, reminiscent of mint leaves and Lemongrass! Generally medium to full bodied with a characteristic flinty after taste. Excellent with seafood or goats cheese.

2008 HAMILTON RUSSELL (Walker Bay, Hermanus) R530

Balanced, with understated oaking, and grape's natural limey tones displayed quite vividly.



BLENDED REDS

Gutsy Cabernets give backbone to many medleys, increasingly with Shiraz in the Cape style red and Merlot in the classic French Bordeaux genre. Look for drinkability, berry fruits and soft tannins with staying power and enjoy with handsomely flavoured casseroles.

2009 HARTENBERG CAB SAUV/SHIRAZ (Stellenbosch) R110

Juicy full flavoured berry richness, stylish and silky balance, moreish flavours, good long aftertaste and uncomplicated quality wine matured in small French oak barrels.

2009 THELEMA MOUNTAIN RED (Stellenbosch) R130

Ripe red fruit with a spicy and complex character. Drinking very well at the moment, but will develop well over the next few years.

2008 CAPAIA BLUE GROVE HILL BARON VON ESSEN (Philadelphia) R165

Second label of new outstanding estate by Alexander Baron von Essen.

2007 RAKA QUINARY (Klein river, Stanford) R170

A well balanced Cabernet led Bordeaux with complex nose of blackberries, spice and liquorice.

2009 RUPERT & ROTHSCHILD CLASSIQUE (Paarl) R210

Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot blend, matured in small barrels of new French oak. Dense, blackish colour with ruby hues and flavours of ripe plum with cherry tobacco.

2006 JOUBERT-TRADAUW R62 (Tradouw Vallel, Barrydale) R 220

Good ripe berries merlot/cab blend, well structured, a little hot on the finish.

2007 WARWICK "THREE CAPE LADIES" (Stellenbosch) R230

Full on the palate with good length on the finish. This beautiful cape blend brings the best of Pinotage to the classic French varieties.

2007 FUNDI STELLEKAYA (Stellenbosch) R250

A rich melange of summer berries with smooth and juicy fruits on the palate.

2005 VRIESENHOF KALLISTA (Stellenbosch) R280

Merlot dominated Bordeaux blend with mouth bursting ripe blackberry flavour.

2009 DE TOREN Z (Stellenbosch) R335

Rose petals, plum and blueberry fruits. Acidity is frisky and well integrated to bring freshness to the front of this elegant wine.

2010 BOEKENHOUTSKLOOF CHOCOLATE BLOCK (Franschhoek) R335

Fresh berry flavours and fine white pepper add a spicy profile to the nose. This is a wine of elegance and linearity. The palate seems almost seamless with soft approachable tannins.

2006 AND 2007 BOUCHARD FINLAYSON HANNIBAL (Walker Bay, Hermanus) R380

Well balanced combination of Sangiovese, Pinot Noir, Nebbiolo, Barbera and Shiraz. Floral tones and red berries with silky tannins and cool mineral undertone.

2009 DE TOREN FUSION V (Stellenbosch) R580

A superb example of a five varietal, Bordeaux style blend made with South African excellence. Possibly one of the best red blends on the plane

2006 KANONKOP PAUL SAUER (Stellenbosch) R760

Mostly Cabernet Sauvignon, with a little Merlot and Cabernet Franc. Intensely spicy with well integrated oak and concentrated black currants.



MERLOT

Reliable in blends and accessible alone, Merlot delivers an array of flavours; chocolate, violets and even smoked pork amongst them. Plump fresh fruit with soft acids make it versatile with food, or good to drink on its own.

2009 VILLIERA (Stellenbosch) R130

*Densely textured, a benchmark wine.
Spicy mulberry layered with almost creamy plum textures.*

2009 MAJORS HILL (Robertson) R175

*Refined and elegantly structured Merlot with black berry, ripe plums
and hints of smokiness completed by soft tannins.*

2007 STERHUIS (Stellenbosch) R190

*Serious yet very accessible flavours with plums, mulberries chocolate and coffee on the nose.
The palate is rich in ripe black fruits with integrated oak flavours and a velvety soft tannin finish.*

2008 JORDAN (Stellenbosch) R215

*A full-bodied wine with rich plum flavours and soft rounded tannins. The full fruitiness
of the variety integrates well with the toasty coffee flavours of French oak.*

2008 SAXENBURG PRIVATE COLLECTION (Stellenbosch) R245

*Among South Africa's best, most sophisticated.
Dark fruit opulence with attractive bitter chocolate core and long reach.*

2008 THELEMA (Stellenbosch) R260

Deliciously spicy, fragrant red with firm structure to reward cellaring.

2004 and 2006 HARTENBERG (Stellenbosch) R270

*Dark plum with roasted spices and silky texture. A very approachable Merlot
that should be drinking especially well at this stage of its life.*

2008 MEERLUST (Stellenbosch) R420

*Dalla Cia's passion – sweet, luscious, cascading fruit with a long reach.
Particularly rich, mocha, violets and truffle/game characters.*

PINOT NOIR

*How subtle and elegant power can be. A "minx of a wine", good Pinot is difficult to make, seldom cheap,
but worth every cent. Don't be deterred by the light colour or tawny edge. Search for spicy fruit or
vegetable whiffs and savour restrained rather than brute force with gamey fish, pork or veal.*

2011 TWO OCEANS (Stellenbosch) R85

Medium-bodied with ripe strawberry aromas, a hint of smokiness and smooth velvety finish.

2007 HAUTE CABRIÈRE (Franschhoek) R280

*An absolute stunner. Splendid cherry-strawberry fruit layered elegantly
but deeply throughout.*

2007 BOUCHARD FINLAYSON GALPIN PEAK (Walker Bay) R500

*Made from new clone Pinot. Walnut and plum perfumes intermingle with a
smoky fragrance that leads into rich black cherry flavours.*

2008 HAMILTON RUSSELL (Walker Bay) R525

*Sweetish strawberry-candy floss flavours. This wine has become most
South Africans' Pinot benchmark.*



SHIRAZ

Whilst smoke and sweaty saddles defined the style of older local Shiraz, many now have green pepper and spicy notes of the French Rhône where the grapes are at home. Filled out by wood, they match lamb, beef or cassoulet.

2009 SIMONSIG (Stellenbosch) R135

Matured in used oak for more fruity elegance.

2008 BELLINGHAM (Franschhoek) R140

Ripe black berry, fragrant violet and spice overtures perfectly supported by firm ripe tannins and seamless oak integration.

2009 DURBANVILLE HILLS (DURBANVILLE) R150

This Shiraz is deep red in colour. The nose is toasty and smoky with spicy pepper, cloves and vanilla. You'll also notice hints of fruits and spices which combine well on the palate with tasting notes of vanilla and sweet wood.

2008 RAKA BIOGRAPHY (Klein River, Stanford) R185

Peppery Karoo bush aromas with hints of vanilla sweetness and linden. These aromas follow through on a silky full body palate, with ripe plum and chocolate flavours. Well rounded tannins ending in a pleasant, long lingering aftertaste.

2005 KANU (Stellenbosch) R190

Made from specially selected, prime Stellenbosch fruit. Sleek and flavourful with solid quality wood tannins, hints of berries, nutmeg and cloves.

2009 ANDREAS (Paarl) R215

Hand crafted and produced in small amounts. Red-black in colour with aromatic pepper and subtle chocolate on the nose with sweet ripe berry flavours following on the palate.

2008 EDGEBASTON (Stellenbosch) R230

Mulberry, violets and smoky vanilla notes on the nose, with dry ripe tannins on the palate. Double gold Michelangelo 2007 wine awards.

2006 SAXENBERG PRIVATE COLLECTION (Stellenbosch) R270

Deep purple, full-ripe flavours. An excellent wine to be enjoyed with great cuisine. Farm's flagship wine consistently top rated and received 4½ stars in John Platter.

2007 HARTENBERG (Stellenbosch) R285

Tobacco, roasted coffee, spicy earthiness adding character. Rated 4½ stars in WINE magazine.

2003 ANNANDALE (Stellenbosch) R380

The flagship of Annandale! This Shiraz spent four years in 100% new French Oak. A true reflection of the Du Toit family's passion for winemaking.

OTHER INTERESTING VARIETIES

2005 EIKENDAL CABERNET FRANC (Stellenbosch) R155

Elegant lightly textured and well balanced with a long velvety finish and passing hints of herb and youngberry flavours.

2007 & 2009 ALTYDGEDACHT BARBERA (Durbanville) R180

Full bodied complex wine with soft ripe tannins and packed with cherry and black current.

2006 LOVANE PETIT VERDOT (Stellenbosch) R300

A duplex, yet elegant smooth wine with flavours of rich dark berries and plums lingering on the tongue.



CABERNET SAUVIGNON

This king of red wine grapes at the heart of fine Bordeaux has travelled well, a staple of most wine producing countries, soft local versions display blackcurrant and cassis berry fruits with cedar wood nuance. Bracing while young, they mellow with age and go hand in glove with fillet steak.

2009 EXCELSIOR (Robertson) R95

Brimming with abundant blackcurrant aromas, this full-bodied wine is a mouthful of juicy plum flavours. It makes a delicious partner to a wide variety of foods, including chicken, red meats, game, or rich pastas.

2009 BRAMPTON (Stellenbosch) R120

Full bodied with ripe fruit. Cassis is prominent with blackberries, cherries, cigar box and spice. High quality and great value this wine will go well with meat dishes and fine cheeses.

2009 DIEMERSFONTEIN (Wellington) R170

Plummy and soft, bursting with cassis, herbal undertones and delicate clove spice finish. Will accompany most meat dishes but especially lamb.

2009 KLEINE ZALZE (Stellenbosch) R185

Well managed oak showing nice cedar wood, in balance with sweet fruit and soft, dry tannins. Awards include Michelangelo Gold 2007 and Veritas Gold 2007.

2006 STERHUIS (Stellenbosch) R200

Black cherry fruit, mint and minerals on the nose. The palate is elegant with dark fruit, spicy oak and classical tea leaf flavours resulting in a long, elegant, mineral finish.

2010 SPRINGFIELD WHOLE BERRY (Robertson) R220

Soft tannins and classical varietal characteristics! Dense juicy fruit with typical cassis but also fynbos, tea leaves and citrus flavours.

2002 ANNANDALE (Stellenbosch) R230

Made by Hempies du Toit of Alto fame. Well and elegantly structured; attractive plum fragrance. A well balanced wine.

2006 THELEMA (Stellenbosch) R390

Full, ripe black current flavours and lovely toasty oak combine to produce a classic Thelema-style Cabernet Sauvignon.



PINOTAGE

South Africa's own. Cultivated from Pinot Noir for quality and Hermitage (now called Cinsaut) for quantity, the result was utterly novel. Bright purple when young, it comes packed with baked berry fruits and often sweet American oak. Not for the faint hearted, but great alongside steak or venison.

2010 KEN FORRESTER PETIT PINOTAGE (Stellenbosch) R90

Plump and fruity made from new Pinotage wines. Ripe hints of mulberry and plum.

2010 BEYERSKLOOF (Stellenbosch) R120

A full-bodied Pinotage with a deep red colour. Typical blackberry, cassis flavours on the nose and palate.

2009 DURBANVILLE HILLS (DURBANVILLE) R150

This Pinotage is dark ruby in colour with a bouquet of fresh strawberry and litchi flavours on the nose with a hint of sweet spice. A rich fruity character fills the mouth, backed by silky tannins and hints of berry flavours.

2008&2009 SIMONSIG (Stellenbosch) R140

Produced from 40 year old bush vines; therefore shows excellent concentration of fruit, and black cherry flavour.

2007 HARTENBERG (Stellenbosch) R145

Outgoing with delicious rich fruits, smooth palate and good underlying structure.

2011 DIEMERSFONTEIN (Wellington) R170

Coffee and chocolate overtones with luscious wild berry and rhubarb. Diemersfontein has quite a reputation for their Pinotage. It befriends - It converts - It seduces

2008 ALLEE BLEUE (Franschhoek) R250

Intense violet red colour. Rich ripe cherry flavour on the nose is followed by a complex pallet of liquorice chocolate and an abundance of ripe berry fruits.

2007 KANONKOP (Stellenbosch) R500

This estate put Pinotage on the world wine map. Juicy, ripe flavours, oak vanilla adding charm. Received 5 Star rating from Wine Magazine.

DESSERT WINE

From sun drenched slopes and concentrated by noble rot, good "stickies" will be sweet but not unctuous. Balanced by brisk acid to prevent cloying, the rich heart of the sun emerges in apricot and sweet-sour flavours. For cheese, desserts or to linger over later.

2004 ASARA 'SPIRIT OF CHENIN' WHITE PORT (Stellenbosch) R170

Light-hearted, highly spirited pleasure. 18 months in new French oak, Fortified with barrel-matured spirit.

2001 KLEIN CONSTANTIA VIN DE CONSTANCE (Constantia) 500ml R510
